



# Peek at our WEEK



## HIGHLIGHTS

This week in Science, students chose an animal to research and worked on creating a care guide for that animal. We looked for information about the animal's appearance, habitat, diet, and more!

In Reading, students were assessed on how characters respond to events and challenges in fiction stories. We also practiced asking and answering questions as we read.

In Writing, we completed our informative writing piece about the biome we researched. Students began creating a diorama to represent the climate, plants, and animals within the biome. We will finish this project on Monday next week.

In Math, we reviewed 2D shapes and explored cubes. We drew cubes and then counted the vertices, edges, and faces of this 3D shape. We explored dividing rectangles and circles into equal parts. We also talked about fractions such as halves, thirds, and fourths.

Today was Woodland Day. Ask your child about what we did today!

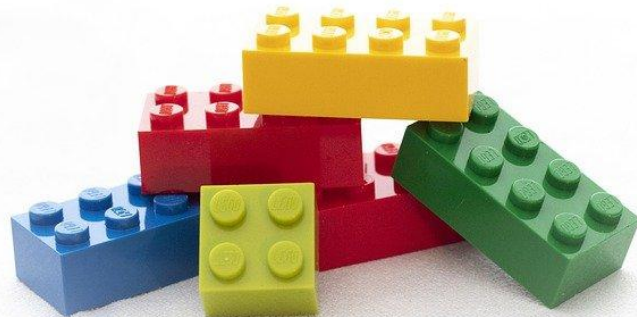
