

## HIGHLIGHTS

This week in Science, we created our own pollinator to observe how they are able to collect pollen to carry to other plants. We also learned about how animals rely on plants in order to survive.

In Reading, students continued to listen to different versions of familiar fairy tales. They identified the point of view of the narrator (1st person or 3rd person). They also compared and contrasted the stories.

In Writing, we finished writing our opinion piece about whether we believe the pigs or the wolf was telling the truth. Students supported their opinions with evidence.

In Math, we focused on drawing arrays and wrote the repeated addition equations to match the arrays we drew. We assessed this skill on Friday.
